Re: Historic Fence from Bushaway Road

On Tuesday 1/5, the City Council again reviewed a fence height variance for 324 Bushaway Road. This property is part of the Stonecrest development. The council's 2012 approval included a condition about the applicant using best efforts to protect the historic fence along Bushaway Rd. The fence had to be removed as part of the construction of the development, but the developer was able to salvage the metal portion of the fence. The owner of the property indicated that the fence is in disrepair and it is not feasible to install the fence back on the property.

The council included a condition of the variance that the owner work with the city to preserve and relocate the fence to another location, which the applicant is agreeable to.

Currently, the fence is in pieces (pictures also attached) and is comprised of 8-10 segments, roughly 18 feet in length.

Dave Dudinsky is looking into if/where the fence could be stored in the interim (currently it is on the property).

HPB will discuss if we want the city to retain it and if so, possible uses and locations.
