## *Memorandum*

FROM: Wayzata City Attorney  
REGARDING: Lake Effect Conservancy

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As directed by Council on May 3, 2016, staff has initiated the process of creating the legal organizational structure for the Lake Effect Conservancy and the negotiation of a “partnership” agreement between the City and the Conservancy for the Lake Effect Signature Park Project.

The purpose of the joint workshop with the Conservancy board designees is to brief the Council on staff’s initial work and findings related to the Conservancy’s legal structure, and to go over the terms of a draft partnership agreement.

A copy of the draft agreement is attached for your review ahead of the workshop meeting. It is based on agreements used in similar contexts, and the discussion on the Conservancy to date. Some of the key terms we will want to review and discuss include:

- Roles and Responsibilities of City
- Roles and Responsibilities of Conservancy
- Shared Roles and Responsibilities
- Process for Selecting and Approving Components of the Project
- Process for Implementing Components
- Coordination of Fundraising
- Coordination of Project Management
- Staffing, point persons, managers

We have not included any proposed organizational documents, as we have concluded that the Conservancy will need to be created by the group of board designees, not by the City, given the limitations of Minnesota state law, Minn. Stat. Sec. 465.717, which preclude cities from creating nonprofit corporations. Thus, the City’s future control of the Lake Effect Signature Park Project will be through its land ownership/rights; land use approvals; local ordinances; permitting and licensing; and the “partnership agreement” with the Conservancy.

**COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT  
BETWEEN THE CITY OF WAYZATA AND THE LAKE EFFECT CONSERVANCY**

This Cooperative Agreement (the “Agreement”) is entered into effective as of \_\_\_\_\_, 2016 (“Effective Date”) by and between the City of Wayzata, MN, a body corporate and politic under the laws of the State of Minnesota, (the “City”) and the Lake Effect Conservancy, a Minnesota non-profit corporation, (the “Conservancy”) related to the City of Wayzata Lake Effect Project.

**RECITALS**

- A.** The City has been engaged in a community-wide multi-year initiative to improve, restore and enhance the areas along the shore of Lake Minnetonka in the City of Wayzata, making it safer, more ecologically friendly, and improving access to and along the shore.
- B.** In July 2012, the City retained the Saint Paul Riverfront Corporation (SPRC) to carry out the Community Planning and Engagement process for the purpose of creating a 10 Year Lakefront Plan. The outcome of this intensive, 16-month initiative was a menu of possible projects for the downtown Wayzata lake front area.
- C.** In December 2014, the Wayzata City Council approved the Implementation Strategy for the “Lake Effect Framework”, including a recommendation to unite a series of the small-scale projects identified in the Framework into one priority “Lake Effect Signature Park Project” for the central lakefront (defined as the area from the Section Foreman’s House west to Shaver Park from Lake Street to the lake front).
- D.** In September 2015, the Wayzata City Council engaged the design firm of Civitas to produce a schematic design for the Lake Effect Signature Park and make related recommendations for proceeding with the project.
- E.** In May 2016, the Wayzata City Council accepted the delivery from Civitas of the work contained in the Schematic Design Book, and directed staff to explore implementation of the schematic design and recommendations, under the close guidance and direction of the City Council, which will establish sequencing and priorities of which components of the Design and Recommendations to pursue, in what sequence, and in what priority, based on needs and feasibility.
- F.** In May 2016, the Wayzata City Council also authorized City Staff to initiate work on the creation of the Conservancy, and an agreement between the City and the Conservancy for partnering on the Lake Effect Project.
- G.** In June 2016, the Conservancy was organized and established with the specific

purposes of providing leadership; advocacy; financial support; building and programming expertise; and long term management, preservation and stewardship of the Lake Effect Project, as such project is defined and approved by the City of Wayzata, MN.

- H.** In consideration of the foregoing, the City and Conservancy now deem it appropriate and necessary to enter into this cooperative agreement (this “Agreement”).

**I. DEFINITIONS**

- A. Lake Effect Project:** “Lake Effect Project” as used in this Agreement means the City of Wayzata’s initiative to improve, restore and enhance the areas along the shore of Lake Minnetonka in the City of Wayzata, making it safer, more ecologically friendly, and improving access to and along the shore, as further defined and approved by the Wayzata City Council. The Lake Effect Project is also referred to as the “Lake Effect Signature Park Project” or the “Signature Project”.
- B. Components:** “Components” as used in this Agreement mean specific components and projects that City Council identifies and approves as part of the Lake Effect Project, some of which may be contained in the Schematic Design Book prepared by Civitas. Possible examples include a “Lake Walk” along the lake shore of Lake Minnetonka, Lake Street improvements, current Section Foreman’s House (to become an eco park), and beach improvements.
- C. Project Level Agreement:** “Project Level Agreement” as used in this Agreement means an agreement between the City and Conservancy addressing specific capital projects for Components of the Lake Effect Project.
- D. Philanthropy:** “Philanthropy” and “Philanthropic” as used in this Agreement means financial and other contributions and commitments from the private sector, including from individuals, corporations, and community, family, and corporate foundations, as well as donor advised funds.
- E. Third Party Funding:** “Third Party Funding” as used in this Agreement means funding through sources other than Philanthropy or standard City capital funds. Examples include funds from other government entities, earned income, and legislative appropriation.

**II. TERM**

This Agreement shall be in effect from the Effective Date through January 1, 2027 with five-year renewal options thereafter, exercisable by mutual written agreement of the City and the Conservancy.

### **III. COOPERATION AND “PARTNERSHIP” MODEL**

The City and the Conservancy agree to work together cooperatively towards realizing the vision and goals of the Lake Effect Project, recognizing the proper roles, responsibilities, capabilities and authority of each that are set forth in this Agreement.

### **IV. ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

#### **A. Shared Roles and Responsibilities**

1. Maintain sustained commitment to the Lake Effect Project as a Wayzata community initiative.
2. Strive to build public awareness of the Lake Effect Project.
3. Share the Lake Effect Project communications and design messaging, promotional media, and graphics.
4. Establish and maintain strong communication and mutual understanding between the parties in pursuit of the Lake Effect Project.
5. Coordinate on Components of the Lake Effect, as specified in Project Level Agreements.

#### **B. City’s Roles and Responsibilities**

1. The City will be the property rights holder of all land and public improvements.
2. City staff will review and make recommendations to City Council on all Components of the Lake Effect Project, as directed by City Council.
3. The Wayzata City Council approval must be obtained for all Components of the Lake Effect Project, in addition to any other approvals required by law.
4. The City will collaborate with the Conservancy on the capital projects related to the Components, as specified in the Project Level Agreements.
5. The City will collaborate with the Conservancy on the ongoing management, programming and maintenance of the Components of the Lake Effect Project.
6. The City will collaborate with the Conservancy on Philanthropic pursuits where public sector involvement, in-kind contributions, or local financial matches are needed.
7. The City will consult with the Conservancy prior to annual budgeting or capital improvement program shifts that could impact any Components.
8. The City will provide a brand and marketing presence for the Conservancy in appropriate media and at City facilities and events.

#### **C. Conservancy’s Roles and Responsibilities**

1. The Conservancy will act as overall stewards for and provide leadership to the Lake Effect Project.
2. The Conservancy will advocate for the implementation and long term sustainability and success of the Lake Effect Project, including through stakeholder cultivation, awareness-building and promotions.

3. The Conservancy will seek Philanthropic and Third Party Funding for all aspects of the Lake Effect Project, including Philanthropic campaigns, and be the primary liaison to the Philanthropic community.
4. The Conservancy will provide building and programming expertise to the Lake Effect Project.
5. The Conservancy will provide long term management, preservation and stewardship of the Lake Effect Project.
6. The Conservancy will collaborate with the City on all aspects of the Lake Effect Project that require City approval or involvement.
7. The Conservancy will not engage in any efforts that are not consistent with its mission as set forth in its articles of incorporation.
8. The Conservancy will seek the appropriate approvals of the Wayzata City Council and abide by the direction of the Council in matters under its authority in this Agreement or otherwise under law.

**V. CONSTRAINTS**

- A. The Conservancy shall abide by all policies and rules of the City.
- B. All restrictions associated with state or federal funding for construction materials, procurement, private advertising, lease/operating arrangements, and use of public land shall be observed even if they impact project flexibility.
- C. All applicable public bidding and City procurement policies and regulations shall be followed.
- D. The ability to maintain project timelines is often beyond the control of the parties due to unforeseeable changes in public funding, land acquisition challenges, permitting delays, soil conditions, and other factors.
- E. Neither the City nor the Conservancy can guarantee third-party funding aspirations identified in Project Level Agreements.
- F. Unforeseen fluctuations occur in the Philanthropy environment and general economy that could impact the Conservancy's ability to achieve fundraising milestones that may be identified in Project Level Agreements.
- G. Both parties have limits to organizational capacity, especially in the areas of staffing and financial resources.
- H. Constructing capital projects according to the design intent envisioned during fundraising campaigns as wells as operating those projects once open to a high standard of care with robust programming will impact on-going Philanthropic success.

**VI. FUNDRAISING**

- A. The Conservancy will raise funds for the Lake Effect Project. Project Level Agreements will outline fundraising specifics for the Components.
- B. The Conservancy will coordinate and lead the pursuit of Philanthropy including donor prospect strategy, communications, and timing and as further agreed to for specific projects and Components.
- C. The City will direct Philanthropic inquiries and opportunities to the Conservancy.
- D. Third Party Funding pursuits as identified will be closely coordinated between the City and Conservancy.
- E. The City will actively pursue State and/or Federal funding for the Lake Effect Project

**VII. DECISION-MAKING**

The following steps will be taken to streamline decision-making as it relates to the work of the Conservancy and the City for the Lake Effect Project:

- A. A team consisting of no more than four (4) people made up of representation from each party (“Lake Effect Team”) will be designated to provide input on key issues if/when they arise, and meet at least once yearly to review the current year’s progress and prepare a general Lake Effect Project work plan for the upcoming year.
- B. If any issue or conflict arises, every attempt will be made to resolve them at the staff level. If staff resolution is not possible, lead staff will bring disputes to the Lake Effect Team who will seek consensus and recommendations to the parties on the issue.

**VIII. STAFFING**

The City and the Conservancy will each designate a lead staff person responsible for Lake Effect Project activities to act as liaison and point of contact (“Lead Staff Person”). Staff assigned to Conservancy activities will have sufficient authority and workload capacity to meet the expectations outlined in this Agreement.

**IX. MEASURES OF SUCCESS**

Upon formation, the Lake Effect Team will formulate success metrics. Metrics will address the topics of project quality, innovation, fundraising achievement, gaining third-party involvement, and community perceptions. Each year, the Lead Staff Person will prepare a review of project metrics to be shared with City Council and Conservancy Board members.

**X. GENERAL**

- A.** This Agreement may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, but all of which together shall be deemed to be one and the same agreement. A signed copy of this Agreement delivered by facsimile, e-mail or other means of electronic transmission shall be deemed to have the same legal effect as delivery of an original signed copy of this Agreement.
- B.** Neither party to this Agreement may assign any of its rights or delegate any of its rights or obligations hereunder without the prior written consent of the other party.
- C.** This Agreement may be amended or modified only by a written instrument signed by both of the parties hereto.
- D.** Section headings used in this Agreement have no legal significance and are used solely for convenience of reference.
- E.** This Agreement shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with Minnesota law.



**Re:** Speed Hump Petition – East Neighborhood

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In 2005, the City of Wayzata adopted a Speed Hump Policy in which residents can petition the City Council to install speed humps in a neighborhood that meet the criteria in the speed hump policy. These criteria include:

- The average traffic volume should be less than 1,500 vehicles and more than 200 vehicles in a 24 hour period.
- The street should be less than 28 feet in width, (face to face).
- The street should have no more than two traffic lanes.
- The street should have a speed limit of no more than 30 M.P.H.
- Areas of streets for installation of humps should have a grade of 5% or less.

A complete copy of the speed hump policy is attached for your reference.

Residents from the East neighborhood have submitted a petition for the installation of speed humps on Wise Avenue, Central Avenue South, LaSalle Street, and Circle Drive E, as depicted on the attached map.

The residents of LaSalle Street are requesting that the existing stop signs at Hampton Street and Reno Street be removed, if speed humps are installed.

The residents in the area of Huntington Avenue seem to prefer that the stop signs at the Circle Drive E/Huntington Avenue intersection remain in place if speed humps are installed.

The petition district was defined by Public Works staff and included 98 properties. Of the 98 properties, there are three (3) vacant lots and eight (8) properties under construction. The attached, signed petition includes signatures from 45 of the 87 occupied properties. This exceeds the 50% threshold required by the policy for the installation of speed humps. A copy of the signed petition is attached for your review.

A notice was sent to all property owners in the project petition district, last week. Proposed locations for the speed humps were marked with stakes and red ribbons on Wednesday, June 8<sup>th</sup>.


Should the project be ordered by the City Council, Public Works will implement installation of the speed humps in July.






