March 6, 2018

5:30 p.m. Future IQ Report on Wayzata 2040 Community Vision

Mayor Pro-Tem Tyacke called the workshop meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. Council Members present: Koch, McCarthy, and Plechash. Absent and excused: Mayor Willcox. Also present: City Manager Dahl, Director of Planning and Building Thomson, City Engineer/Assistant Director of Public Works Kelly, and City Consultants David Beurle and Juliana Panetta of Future IQ.

Mayor Pro-Tem Tyacke introduced this item at 5:30 p.m.

Mr. Dahl explained that during the summer of 2017, the City Council hired Future IQ to conduct a comprehensive community engagement process that would ultimately provide the vision and foundation for the update to the City's Comprehensive Plan, which the Met Council is requiring all of seven-county area communities to do by no later than December 31, 2018.

David Beurle and Juliana Panetta of Future IQ reviewed the report with the group, including the process over the last six months. The City chose to invest more in the engagement phase of the process in order to better grasp influences and trends of the region, country, world, and to provide for more feedback opportunities.

The group critiqued the draft vision statement and reviewed the eight (8) guiding principles that support the implementation of the Wayzata 2040 Vision: Charming; Walkable and Pedestrian Friendly; Healthy, Engaged and Active; Vibrant Parks and City Spaces, In the Forefront of Sustainability: Multi-Generational; Connected and City Nodes with Greater Housing Diversity.

The Council discussed feedback received throughout the process and next steps. Mr. Beurle and Ms. Panetta indicated that would make some tweaks to the Visioning document prior to sending back to the City. Once they do that, it is ready to be incorporated into the Comprehensive Plan Update.

Future iQ and the Council thanked each other for the partnership. Mr. Dahl indicated that at the March 20 Council meeting, there would be consideration to approve additional contracts from the consultants who would finish the remaining portion of the Comp Plan Update.

The workshop meeting was adjourned at 6:55 pm.
