MILL STREET PARKING STRUCTURE

Adolfson & Peterson (A&P) and their subcontractors continue work on the Mill Street Parking Structure project. The installation of the retaining wall, along the east and north side of the ramp, began in late mid-January. The contractor is currently “drilling and dropping” large steel posts which provide the structure of the wall. They have also been installing a formwork between these posts, which will support both tie-backs and the concrete fascia. As this formwork is installed, the contractor will begin excavating the hillside away from the wall. This work is anticipated to continue through February. Because of the space required to perform this work (equipment, materials, and soil), A&P will be stopping the installation of footings and columns along the south edge of the ramp, until late February. Construction is running on schedule for a summer 2017 completion.

ANNUAL STORM WATER INFORMATIONAL MEETING

The City of Wayzata will hold its annual Stormwater Information Meeting on Monday, March 27 at 5 p.m., in the Community Room at Wayzata City Hall, 600 Rice Street East.

A brief presentation will be given regarding the city's Surface Water Management Plan (SWMP) and Storm Water Pollution Prevention Program (SWPPP). Staff will then accept oral or written comments from attendees regarding the city's current programs and future plans for storm water. BLUE BAG ORGANICS

Hennepin County conducted a waste study to figure out what's in our trash and identify the best opportunities to reduce waste and increase recycling. The study found that there are some easy things everyone can do to reduce their trash.

PARTICIPATE IN YOUR ORGANICS PROGRAM

Composting organic materials, which include food and compostable paper, is the biggest opportunity to reduce our trash. Organics make up about one-quarter of our trash.

Wayzata residents can participate in organics recycling by signing up for Blue Bag Organics at no additional cost. You'll start making a big difference in reducing your trash right away. Contact Randy's Environmental services at 763-972-3335 or custserv@randyssanitation.com to sign up.

HOW DOES BLUE BAG ORGANICS WORK:

1. Collect organics throughout your home, including the kitchen, bathroom and bedrooms. Blue bags are provided by Randy's.
2. Empty your organics into the compostable Blue Bags provided by Randy's.
3. Tie the Blue Bags shut and place them in your regular trash cart for curbside pickup. Blue Bags are separated from the trash and sent to a composting site.

PREVENT FOOD WASTE

Food waste is the most prevalent material in the trash by far, representing 19 percent of the trash by weight. Steps you can take to reduce food waste include using up all of the food that you buy, practicing meal planning, understanding the date labels on food, and properly storing your food.
