**ORDINANCE NO. 800**

**AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE**  
**GRANTING CITY MANAGER AUTHORITY TO REVIEW APPLICATIONS AND**  
**ISSUE PERMITS FOR TEMPORARY OUTDOOR PATIOS**

**PREAMBLE:**

Pursuant to City Council Resolution 12-2020 Adopting and Extending the Mayor’s Declaration of Local Emergency Under Minnesota Statutes Section 12.29, 12.37 and 13D.021 (the “Local Emergency”) related to the Novel Coronavirus Disease 2019, commonly known as COVID-19, and based on the recommendations of the City Manager and the acute need for the restaurants in the City to reopen on June 1, 2020 as permitted by the Governor’s Executive Order 20-56, the City Council hereby declares that an emergency exists to immediately preserve and protect the public peace, health, safety and welfare related to the swift, orderly, and safe reopening and operation of the City’s restaurants and other establishments that may operate in a lawful manner after June 1, 2020.

**THE CITY OF WAYZATA ORDAINS:**

**Section 1. Administrative Review and Approval of Temporary Outdoor Patio Permits during Local Emergency.** Notwithstanding any other provision of City Code, and pursuant to the Local Emergency Declaration and Executive Order 20-56, until the end of the Local Emergency or December 31, 2020, whichever is sooner, the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to modify or suspend normal notice, hearing, and City Council review and approval procedures for City- issued permits and licenses related to Outdoor Patios, and to grant such licenses and permits for the safe and lawful operation of Outdoor Patios in conformance with Executive Order 20-56 and the operational standards of Wayzata City Code.

**Section 2. Effective Date.** This Ordinance will become effective immediately upon passage.
