6:00 p.m. Update of 2020 Election

18 Mayor Willcox called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Pursuant to Minnesota Statute Sec. 13D.015 and
19 because of the COVID-19 pandemic, the City Council Meeting was being held remotely by electronic
20 means using the audio conferencing platform, Zoom. Council Members present: Buchanan, Koch,
21 McCarthy and Plechash. Also present: City Manager Jeff Dahl, Public Works Director/City Engineer,
22 Mike Kelly, and Scott Jordan, Civitas (City's lead designer for Panoway project).

23 Mr. Dahl stated that the objective of the workshop was to provide an update on the 2020 Elections.
24 Recently, Hennepin County offered cities a reduced in-person absentee period for the state primary
25 election which included being open for in-person absentee voting for the full 46-day period, only the last
26 7 days (direct balloting) or not all. The flexibility was offered because of COVID-19.

27 The Council felt it was important to allow the normal process to continue and determined that allowing
28 in-person absentee voting during the full 46-day period prior to the election was the most democratic
29 option.

36 Walker to Barry Avenues and discussed potential amendments to the previously approved landscaping
37 plans.


38 Scott Jordan of Civitas provided an update on what was previously approved, what the property owners
39 are requesting and providing possible solutions.

40 Dennis Marhula, representing the Home Owners Association of Wayzata Place, provided updated
41 information on the impacts the various landscaping options would have on the viewshed of Wayzata
42 Place's residents.

43 Ultimately, the Council directed staff to move forward with the staff proposed "Hybrid" Option and gave
authority to work out any remaining details.

The workshop meeting was adjourned at 06:50 pm.
