6:15 p.m. Discussion of Planned 2021 James J. Hill Days by Greater Wayzata Area Chamber of Commerce and 2021 Beach Bash

Mayor Mouton called the meeting to order at 6:15 p.m. The workshop was held in-person in the Community Room at City Hall. Council Members present: Plechash, Buchanan, Iverson and MacDonald. Also present: City Manager Jeff Dahl, Public Works Director/City Engineer Mike Kelly, and Interim Police Chief Marc Schultz.


Mr. Dahl asked Chamber President Becky Pierson to discuss in more detail this year's event with the council and the proposed changes to the layout of the event. Ms. Pierson noted that Panoway impacts the location for some of the vendors on Lake Street and that allowing the event to locate within the 700 block would be helpful. She noted that she has reached out to some businesses about that possibility and is still collecting feedback. She asked that the Council consider it as a possibility when they come back to the Council for approval.

Public Works Director/City Engineer Mike Kelly and Interim Police Chief Marc Schultz indicated they were in preliminary discussions about the event but have not received a Special Event Permit yet. Mr. Schultz indicated that he intended to get police help from other jurisdictions this year as staffing would be tight and he wanted to err on the side of caution in terms of having resources to keep the community safe.

Rick Born, Operator of the Beach Bash Concert Series indicated that for the first time in three years, he is planning a return to his beach bash festival to coincide with James J. Hill Days. He indicated that he had submitted a Special Event Permit earlier that day and will work with the City to have the appropriate amount of private security, BNSF police, and City police.

The workshop meeting was adjourned at 6:35 p.m.
