Panoway on Wayzata Bay Vision Emerges From Construction on Lake Street

Throughout the month of May, construction crews continued to make significant progress on Lake Street related to phase one of Panoway on Wayzata Bay.

Plaza Park Construction Begins

A major milestone was accomplished in May, as crews demolished the parking lot near the COV restaurant to make way for a new park space that is part of phase one of Panoway on Wayzata Bay.

Panoway on Wayzata Bay is a public/private partnership to restore and revitalize the Lake Minnetonka waterfront. The first phase of the project is focused on investing in Wayzata's infrastructure and streetscape to create an environment that is friendly to walkers, bikers and cars.



Additionally, the first phase will include transforming the parking lot at Lake and Broadway into a new plaza park. The park will feature a viewing area of the lake, public seating, green space, water feature and a fire pit. The park will be a place to relax, refresh and reconnect right along the shores of Lake Minnetonka.

Panoway is funded by a public/private partnership led by the City of Wayzata, Three Rivers Park District, the State of Minnesota and the Wayzata Conservancy, which is raising private funds for the project. Additionally, the City is seeking \$10 million in bonding from the State of Minnesota to help fund the second phase of Panoway on Wayzata Bay. This phase will include:

- Building a lakeside boardwalk and community docks.
- Enhancing the Wayzata Depot park area to make it more accessible.
- Creating a new Eco Park and shoreland restoration to provide habitat for a wide variety of wildlife and filter out pollutants and runoff that degrade the lakes water quality.
- Restoring the historic Section Foreman House to create a community room and an interactive learning center for history and the environment.



Lake Street Closed Until Late July

Lake Street is expected to remain closed to vehicle traffic through the end of July, with the full project scheduled to be complete by late summer.

As construction continues, businesses will remain accessible, and the sidewalks on the north side of the road will stay open. Parking is available in the municipal parking lots off Broadway and Walker avenues. Please follow the posted detour signs.

Fire Department

When your summer plans include making s'mores or creating a relaxing mental getaway by the glow of an outdoor fire, please follow a few safety guidelines from the Wayzata Fire Department.

- Recreational fire regulations
- Burning waste material is prohibited.
- Fires must be a minimum of 25 feet away from any combustible material.
- Fires must be inside a non-combustible fire ring.
- Fires should not be more than 36 inches around and 36 inches high.
- Fires must be attended by an adult at all times.
- A fire extinguisher or hose connected to water must be readily available for use.

The Wayzata Fire Department may prohibit any or all recreational fires when atmospheric conditions or local circumstances make such fires hazardous.

City Hall and Motor Vehicle Department Reopen June 2

Wayzata City Hall and the Motor Vehicle Department, 600 Rice St East, will reopen to the public at 7 a.m., Tues., June 2, after being closed due to Minnesota Governor's Stay at Home Executive Order issued in March. The Public Works building and the Police Department will remain closed to the public.

Visitors to City facilities will notice measures in place to keep visitors and employees safe:

- Hand sanitizer stations at entrances and in vestibules.
- Plexi-glass dividers (sneeze guards) between staff and visitors and customer service counters.
- Social distancing signs on the floor to assist with proper spacing as it relates to waiting in line for services.
- Frequent cleaning and sanitizing operations in bathrooms, and in service and employee areas.
- Visitors to City Hall are encouraged to wear face masks.

These measures were put in place to ensure compliance with the Governor's Stay Safe Mn Executive Order, social distancing protocols and mitigating the potential spread of the Coronavirus.
