An Ending to COVID-19 Restrictions in MN

On Friday May 14th, Governor Walz lifted the statewide mask mandate following the CDC announcement that vaccinated individuals no longer need to wear a mask. The state continues to recommend unvaccinated Minnesotans mask up to protect themselves and their neighbors.

Following that announcement, on May 28th remaining capacity and distancing limits came to an end, including for indoor events and gatherings. The state requires that businesses and other venues have plans to keep their employees and customers safe – as they have from the beginning of the pandemic. The City of Wayzata will continue to align its policies and communication with the state.

To continue the momentum of progress through the summer, the state recommends all Minnesotans consider receiving the COVID-19 vaccination.

The CDC states that "Millions of people in the United States have received COVID-19 vaccines, since they were authorized for emergency use by FDA. These vaccines have undergone and will continue to undergo the most intensive safety monitoring in U.S. history. This monitoring includes using both established and new safety monitoring systems to make sure that COVID-19 vaccines are safe."
